



JOB DESCRIPTION

Title: Dishwasher

FLSA STATUS: Non Exempt

Department: Glenwoodie Golf course

GENERAL PURPOSE

Under the supervision from the Head Cook, the dishwasher is the primary person to ensure all dishes, glassware, cutlery and pots and pans in the kitchen are sanitized for the public and the other workers in the restaurant.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Cleans all of the dishes, glassware, cutlery and pots and pans the kitchen uses.
- Stack plates, glassware, and utensils for servers to use or put away.
- Takes garbage out, clears out drains of sink, and filters in the dishwashing machine and mops the floor near the dishwashing area.
- Any other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Ability to provide legible communication
2. Ability to focus attention on details, speed and accuracy.
3. Ability to work with minimal supervision

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to reach with hands and arms. The employee frequently is required to stand; talk or hear, walk and use hands to finger, handle, feel or operate objects, tools, or controls. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.

The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 10 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move more than 20 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

This position requires that the person stand or walk most of the time with bending, stooping, squatting, twisting, reaching, and working on irregular surfaces or at heights above the ground.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee may occasionally works near moving mechanical parts.
