ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 15

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING NEW SECTION 102-440 AND AMENDING APPENDIX C OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENWOOD'S CODE OF ORDINANCES IN ORDER TO ADDRESS THE OVERNIGHT PARKING OF VEHICLES ON VILLAGE STREETS.**

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees determines that it is in the public interest to add new Section 102-440 and amend Appendix C of the Village of Glenwood's Code of Ordinances in order to preclude the overnight parking of certain vehicles on village streets that are not displaying a valid vehicle license sticker and have not otherwise obtained an exemption from this overnight parking requirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glenwood, Cook County Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers as follows:

**SECTION 1: Amendment to Section 102-440.**

The Village's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add new Section 102-440 which shall provide as follows:

**Sec. 102-440. Overnight parking.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on a Village street between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. unless the vehicle displays a valid Village vehicle license sticker. Except, this prohibition shall not apply to vehicles that are not registered in Glenwood if an exemption has been requested from the police department prior to the issuance of any violation by contacting the police department by telephone at 708-753-2420 and advising the department of the following information: (1) the name and address of the owner of the vehicle; (2) the color, make, model, and license plate number on the vehicle; (3) the dates when the exemption will be required which shall not be for a period of more than 7 [days] process can be repeated one time; and (4) the address in front of which the vehicle will be legally parked. The police department shall maintain a log of calls received identifying the information required above as well as the date and time that the request for an exemption was made. The owner of a vehicle parked in violation of this Section 102-440 shall be fined \$40.00 for each violation.

**SECTION 2: Amendment to Appendix C.**

Appendix C of the Village's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add the following new section which shall provide as follows:

102-440(a)	Parking a non-exempt vehicle on a Village street between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. that does not displays a valid Village vehicle license sticker.	\$40.00	N/A

**SECTION 3: Home Rule.**

This Ordinance, and each of its terms, shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such Ordinance should: (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law; or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Glenwood that to the extent that the terms of this Ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, this Ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

**SECTION 4: Invalidity.**

In the event any portion of this ordinance is found to be invalid, the remaining portions of this ordinance shall be severible from any such invalid portion and enforced to the fullest extent possible.

**SECTION 5: Effective date.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

**SECTION 6: Repealer.**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other existing ordinances of the Village to the extent there may be any conflict.




