

FEMA Recovery Center in Homewood

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA) and Cook County Emergency Management and Regional Security (CCEMRS) will be using the Homewood Auditorium for a Disaster Recovery Center on Sunday, October 13 through Wednesday, November 6.

The Disaster Recovery Center will serve as an area and regional facility that will provide assistance to individuals impacted by the July 13th thru 16th, 2024, severe storms, tornadoes, straight-line winds and flooding. Specialists from FEMA, the State of Illinois and the U.S. Small Business Administration will be at the center to help survivors apply for federal disaster assistance, upload documents, get their questions answered in person, access other types of help that may be available and learn ways to make their property more disaster resistant. Assistance in languages other than English, including American sign language, and translated materials will be available at the centers.
