## DEMOLITION SPECIFICATIONS

### **1. Examination of Jobsite:**

The contractor shall personally examine and thoroughly acquaint himself/herself with the specific site where the demolition work is to be performed. He shall note the actual conditions and requirements of the job, including the means of access, safety issues, risk issues, character of the soil and sub-soil and regulations of the surrounding addresses and structures.

### **2. Safety Precautions:**

The contractor shall avoid all hazards to persons, adjacent property and structures. There shall be no interference with the means of access or free passage to and from the surrounding structures. The contractor shall be responsible to avoid the spreading of dust, debris or flying particles to the surrounding area. Once the demolition is started the work will continue promptly and expeditiously until the job is finished, if it is necessary to leave the jobsite, the contractor shall secure the site with a suitable fence or equal system to prevent the public from entry and injury.

### **3. Utility Services:**

Prior to the start of any demolition to any structure the contractor shall check with all utilities including electric, gas, water, telephone and cable service companies for shut off or removal of service in accordance with the requirements and regulations of the utility companies. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor that if any damage occurs to any utility service it shall be repaired at the contractor's expense. The contractor shall submit to the Village of Glenwood that all disconnect have been completed before any work can start.

### **4. Demolition and Removal of Structures:**

The demolition and removal of all buildings and structures of each named address shall consist of foundation, footings, wall, column, slabs, floors, piers, partitions and anything else down to 2 foot below finished grade. All debris and refuse is to be removed from site and site is to be filled with approved material and leveled.

All public sidewalks, streets and alleys shall be left in place unless otherwise ordered and authorized by the Village Building Department.

### **5. Burning:**

Under **no circumstance** shall the contractor, his employees or representative use any kind of explosive or burn or caused to be burned at any time, within the site of the work any paper, wood, or any combustible refuse or material resulting from the wrecking or other operations under this contract.

### **6. Explosives:**

The use of any kind of explosives is strictly prohibited.

### **7. Damage or Theft:**

The Village of Glenwood does not assume any responsibility for any building or contents thereof, including but not limited to salvageable furnishings, fixtures or whatever kind or nature being in the same condition as existed at the time of advertising for bids or thereafter. The Village shall not be held liable to the contractor for any loss, destruction, theft or removal of any property from the premises; nor shall the contractor be entitled to any allowance or other claim against the Village should any of said acts occur.
