Families should arrive early to ensure their hunt is not missed and to allow ample time to get to each location. "We ask that children bring their own baskets or bags to collect the eggs and encourage parents to bring their cameras. It's really a charming opportunity to have fun with your children, take pictures with the Bunny and celebrate Easter and spring," says Schranz.
